BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL GATHERING AREAS

A note for parents :

BEFORE SCHOOL: People are free to come into school before 8.30am if your arrangements require this. We ask that all children and parents who enter the school before the bell rings stay in the concrete area in front of the Library until 8.30am. When parents take their children to their rooms, or move outside the gathering place, that then encourages other children to start moving around the school. As we do not have teachers supervising around the area at that time we want everyone in the one place. I note many other schools do not let children enter the grounds - we want to be a little more understanding and flexible around this.

AFTER SCHOOL - a notice for Kowhai parents: we want to try and keep the area outside our junior rooms and new deck area clear up to 3.00pm. Increasing numbers of our wonderful whanau are arriving before the end of the day. While it is neat to have you here, it is proving to be a distraction to our students (many think the day is all done when they see parents outside!). If you could wait on the concrete outside the Library or by the dental clinic and let your children come to you that would be a great help.
