GMS FUNDRAISING FOCUS FOR THE NEXT TWO YEARS



One of the main issues with our school is a lack of an adequate sized hall. The current one cannot fit all our children in at the same time, and is much smaller than halls many other schools have. Unfortunately we have had it confirmed by the Ministry of Education that construction of a new hall for GMS is very unlikely to feature for many years. We desperately need a covered area that we can gather in outside, protected by the rain and sun. The Heart of the School could be this place, but it is not really big enough.

Our Board of Trustees and PTA have now set a goal of creating a covered court area between the senior playground and

Rooms 8 to 11, similar to the one in the picture. This will serve as a multipurpose area. A sheltered assembly spot (with sides and lighting) is one function. Also this space will have astroturf court markings for tennis, netball, basketball, volleyball and a small hockey training space -it will be a fantastic resource. Think about a way to host visiting performers, dance groups, concerts ... you name it- this will be able to do it! This year's Food Fair funds will go towards this project.

A NOTICE FROM STUDENTS ON ROAD PATROL

Hi, we are Casey and Chloe. We do Road Patrol on a Wednesday on Osier Road. We do Road Patrol to keep the children safe. Some days it gets really busy!

Some things make it harder for us.

- If people park on the yellow lines it is hard for us to see
- If people don't indicate that they are turning in the car parks
- When people stop right in the driveway, it blocks up all the other traffic
- When people park on the ends of the car parks in the church car park it makes it harder for other cars to get around and this blocks the flow of cars in and out
- Adults who ignore us when we put up our barrier arms to stop
- People who do U-turns right in front of the crossing

Things that would make our road patrol easier:

- Crossing straight across the actual crossing
- Don't ignore when we have our arms out to stop
- Wait for 'Cross Now'
- Please do not let your children get into the cars unless you are in a car park - it is really dangerous
- A suggestion might be park further down the road
- Try using the Walking Bus
- Walking together with friends instead of going in the car.

All these things keep the GMS kids safe and make the Road Patrollers job easier. Thank you.
