We have been liaising with The Warehouse and they apologise for any supply issues regarding our uniforms. They are still adjusting to selling school uniforms but have given a commitment to give us excellent service.

They currently have most of our stock out in the shop and ready for purchase. They hope to have everything running smoothly within the next week or so.

Unfortunately the business transfer from Postie to The Warehouse has meant that the timing of the 'sale day' with 20% discount is a little unclear. They have given a commitment that there will be 'sale' days, but these will be advertised nationally as part of The Warehouse promotional activities (and not for individual schools). If we get any indication of dates we will inform you. Please note there is no guarantee The Warehouse will offer a sale day (or weekend?) before our uniform becomes compulsory for all Year 1 to 4 students before the start of Term 2.
