### SUPPORTING NEPAL

The Sausage Sizzle was cancelled for Nepal as our day on Tuesday (yesterday) just got busier with the swimming sports and the Feed the Bus campaign.

Greenmeadows School has now three main fundraisers to help the recovery efforts.

- 1. A sale of old Library books in the Hall on Monday 25 May. Books can be purchased by donation — all the money will go towards the earthquake fund relief.
- 2. A Muftiday on Friday 29 May. Wear mufti and bring a gold coin to go towards the relief fund. Mrs Martin has promoted the idea that the children come dressed in one or more bright colours of the Nepalese prayer flags (e.g. blue, yellow, green, red, white)
- 3. Shoe box gifts those families who want to be involved can fill a shoe box of gifts for a child in Nepal. The school will organize the shoe boxes to fill with non-perishable presents and treats.
