SICK CHILDREN

Lately we have had a number of children having suffered from diarrhoea or vomiting returning to school while having not fully recovered. There is a particularly nasty bug around and we do not want to run the risk of it spreading.

Advice from the Ministry of Health is that:

- * children are Infectious while vomiting and diarrhoea lasts, and up to 48 hours after the last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting
- * Keep children home until well, and for 48 hours after the last episode of diarrhoea or vomiting.

The Key To Fight Cancer Is To Be BRAVE!!


