STATIONERY 2010

It is heartening to see so many children arrive at school today with their stationery orders with them. If all children can have their stationery organised by the end of this week, that would be a great help. Taradale Paper Plus have our school stationery packs on sale at very competitive prices, and are open until 6.00pm each night this week.

SCHOOL FEES

Each year schools ask for fee payments from families. The amounts the school requests need some explanation. 1. The **'activity fee'** is a one off amount we request for each child to cover the cost of the range of different things that come along over the course of the school year. This can include costs such as educational trips students go on, transport to the swimming pool for sports or any visiting performers who may come to school. The idea of a





one off charge is to avoid having to constantly ask for small amounts of money on a regular basis, and is a more effective system. This amount is set at \$45 per pupil for the year.

2. Families are also asked for a 'school fee donation'. This form of funding is vital to any school as there is considerable pressure to meet the expenses in providing a quality education for the students. Unfortunately the funding we receive from the Ministry of Education is not sufficient to provide the types of opportunities and meet the actual costs of running an effective school. Coupled with this, Greenmeadows School's decile rating of '7' means we receive considerably less funding than some other schools in the wider community. The more families who support our school and the children by paying this fee helps Greenmeadows School. Remember these amounts are tax deductible. These amounts are \$50 per pupil for the year (capped at \$110 for a family if they have three or more children at school). In addition to this there is a 10% discount on this amount if it is paid by 31 March 2010.

3. Some families are electing to pay their transport costs for the swimming lessons later in the year. The cost of the bus is subsidised by the Board of Trustees and is \$10 per pupil.

We realise that these amounts can place families under pressure, especially at this time of year. Some families elect to pay by internet banking, which is perfectly acceptable. Our school account details for accepting payments is 030631-0194905-00. If you choose to make payments by this method please make sure you include clear information related to the payment, to avoid confusion at our end! Families can also elect to make regular automatic payments (e.g. \$20 per week) over the internet to reduce their accounts by instalments.
