ABSENCES

Our administrative staff do an excellent job of checking each day if all children are accounted for at school. If we have a child who is absent and we have no explanation, then Mrs Anderson will ring or text the family. She will then ring emergency contacts in an attempt to find out where the child is and check that they are safe. If there is no information as a result of these calls, then our school's policy is to inform the local truancy officer and involve them. This happens as a result of our concern for all children and doing all we can to make sure they are safe.

You can help making sure the school knows if your child is going to be absent or late for school before the start of the school day. A message on the school's answer service, email or note should be provided if your child will not be at school to start the day at 9.00am.

If your child is going to be absent from school please do one of the following:

- or text 0279264452 before 9.00am with the reason why your child is absent

Please make sure you do this **before** 9.00am on the morning your child is going to be absent as the office staff are spending a lot time contacting parents to much sure there children are safe.

WALKING BUS

We have two 'Walking Bus' routes at GMS. Children are welcome to join. On Thursday mornings we leave from the Avondale Road end of Park Road at 8.10am and travel along Ross Place and Bowling Road, before turning onto Osier Road. We aim to arrive at school at 8.30am. Most children bring their scooters, so this trip moves along quickly!

On Friday mornings Mr Gibbs leads a walking bus. Anyone is welcome to join the bus but it is most suitable for people who live in the King Street/Elbourne Street/Chester Street area.

Children will be 'picked up' from their houses (or near their houses) from 7.45 am. Mr G then has a staff meeting at 8.10 am so the children wait as a group outside the canteen until the 8.30 bell.

If either Walking School Bus is cancelled due to bad weather or unavailability, an alert will be sent to parents via the GMS app in the 'Mr G's Walking School Bus section'. Parents should subscribe to these alerts.

Classes visit the library each week at an allocated time when students can issue and return books. All books need to be in a book bag before they leave the library and this bag needs to be used at all times to help protect our books. Students can issue books for two weeks.

Overdue or damaged books will be charged to the student. It is the student's responsibility to take care and return all issued books.
