NOTIFYING PARENTS RE: HEAD KNOCKS

In the past we have telephoned parents or caregivers each time a child bumps their head, whether it be minor or serious. For Term 2 we are going to trial texting parents when their child bumps their head if it's a 'minor' bump. By 'minor' we mean that the child is not showing any symptoms of feeling unwell or in distress. If the child appears to be showing any signs of being concussed, confused or distressed, we will phone if we consider it to be more serious in line with the existing school practise.

LOCKDOWN PROCEDURES

As with so many schools and organisations, the events last month in Christchurch have led us to review the policies we have for a possible 'lockdown'. A number of Hawkes Bay schools have been placed in a lockdown situation for various reasons in recent times. The police often make this decision and communicate this, although schools can choose to do so themselves.

If a lock down was to happen at Greenmeadows School then parents and whanau need to work with the school. The school will attempt to provide notification details for parents if the situation allows it to. Otherwise staff will be doing everything they can to keep children out of sight and as secure as possible from any perceived threat. If we are placed in lockdown (and the chances are one day this will happen) then despite this potentially being an inconvenience we will adhere to any instructions given by the Police. In a coming newsletter we will publish our revised procedures for your reference.
