## **SCHOOL FEES AND PAYMENTS**

It is fantastic to see so many of our school students involved with sports this year. Many in our community may not realise this ... but our school subsidizes much of the true cost of sports subscriptions that children are involved in throughout the year. Greenmeadows School chooses to do this to make it as easy as possible to have as many children involved in sport. We also do everything we can to keep subscriptions below a capped amount. The school pays the subscription amounts up front and often before the season or term has started. We then carry this cost until families pay the fees for their children through the invoices we send out.





To make it easier during the year families are able to set up automatic payments to your child's account. These payments will be allocated to outstanding sports & activity fees throughout the year.

Our school account number is 12-3144-0207207-001. Please use your child's name as a reference. Any questions please contact the school office.

#### **ABSENCES**

A reminder that when your child is absent please ensure you contact the school office prior to **9.00am**. The office staff are spending a lot of time following up children's absences from school each day. We also need to know the reason why your child is away, so please leave that information. If your child is absent you can:

- \* phone and leave a message on the answerphone,
- \* send a text to 0279 264 452 or
- \* list your child's absence via the app under the tab "Absentee".

If you do not contact the school office then we are required to mark your child as 'truant'.

It is a Ministry of Education requirement that we know where and why your child is absent. This is recorded on the Ministry's files.
