THURSDAY 24th OCTOBER - 'EVACUATION DRILL'

We will have our own Shake Out Day. We are going to hold our tsunami evacuation drill for Greenmeadows School next Thursday. This is going to be a major exercise, and is part of a New Zealand wide focus on being prepared for an earthquake and tsunami.

The GMS tsunami hikoi to Church Road Winery Thursday 24th October:

- At 1.30pm we will start our tsunami hikoi via the crossing at Gloucester Street and up Osier Road.
- Our evacuation point is the grassed area at Church Road Winery. This is accessed from Tironui Drive.
- This is a walk of 1.7km from our school via Osier Road and through Knightsbridge.
- As part of the drill we want practice releasing children to their parents, if they are available and want to pick them up. They will then be released for the remainder of the day and do not need to return to school
- We anticipate our drill will finish just after 2.15pm on Thursday 24th October.
- All those children who are not picked up will return to school for the remainder of the afternoon.

If parents are going to pick up their children please park on Church Road. Please do not park in the winery carpark. Be aware that Tironui Drive is very narrow and turning around is very difficult.

Research project : Kia tū rangatira ai: Learning, succeeding, and thriving in education

Our school has decided to participate in a strengths-based research project about how students learn, succeed and thrive at Greenmeadows School. This project is being conducted by Dr Melinda Webber from the University of Auckland and has been funded by the Royal Society of New Zealand, Te Apārangi. Our school would like to invite you and your school aged child/ren to take part in this important research project by completing short questionnaires - either online or in hardcopy.

Completing this survey will help our school to find out more about how our students develop positive attitudes, engagement and aspirations towards school, and who their role-model for success are. Overall the questionnaires will help us better understand the personal, teacher, whanau and community factors that positively impact our student learning and success at school.

This study involves you:

- Completing a questionnaire about your child's attitude, engagement at school and their future aspirations. It also asks you to nominate and describe a family, tribal or local role model for your child.
- Understanding that your child is also to complete a questionnaire at school about their attitude, engagement at school and their future aspirations.

The children will complete the questionnaire during school hours in a way that causes the least amount of disruption to their learning. Your child will get help to complete the questionnaire especially if they are younger and they will do this with their buddy class.

If you do not consent for your child to participate in this research project, please sign the form on the next page and return to school as soon as possible. Your child will be provided with other school work to do to while the class completes the questionnaire.
