# **USE OF ST MARY'S PARISH OSIER ROAD CARPARK**

Parking around our school, particularly at the end of the school day, has never been under as much pressure as it is now. Our roll is at a very high number, and far more parents use cars to drop children off than thirty or forty years ago, when lots of children walked or biked to school.

Greenmeadows School is very fortunate to have access to the St Mary's Church car park to use as a drop off area for our students both morning and afternoon. The church authorities are happy to continue the understanding that Greenmeadows School families use this space with care and consideration. We don't have any special rights or privileges there. We need to ensure that we allow this goodwill to continue.

We ask that our parents:

- do not park cars on any grassed areas around the church area, only use the marked car park areas
- please keep the access ways clear within the car park sitting double parked just restricts other vehicles from getting in and out of the parking area, is dangerous and slows everyone else down.
- keep the driveway areas in the car park free. A number of residents live off this car park and we do not want to block their access.
- follow the approach that if the car park is full, then please park on one of the neighbouring streets ... and accept, that sometimes, other people get there before you.
