PARENT INTERVIEWS - 9TH AND 10TH MARCH 2020

In just over three weeks the whole school will be holding parent-teacher interviews. We are having an interview early in the year so teachers and parents get the opportunity to talk about the learning ahead and work together in the best interests of the child. It is also an opportunity for the teachers to find out more about your child, which helps them immensely.

We urge all families to participate in these interviews and have set aside two afternoons for these to occur:

Monday 9 March 2.15 pm - 5.30 pm 6.15 pm - 7.30 pm Tuesday 10 March 2.15 pm - 7.00 pm

Thursday 8 March additional times for Rooms 14a and 14b collaborative classroom interviews from 3.15pm. Note: when booking for the Room 14 classes you will meet with both teachers, so only book with Room 14a and b - Mrs Groenveld.

You can request an interview by using our online booking program. Go to our school website www.gms.school.nz and click on the 'Parent - Teacher Interviews 2020' tab. There you will see instructions to take you to the interview booking website, along with the necessary code for booking dates and times at our school (remember to use the school code which is 'yz44f'). Once your booking is completed you will receive an email confirming your interview. These details can be rescheduled if your availability changes.

If you are unable to access the school's website, then you can ring, or visit, the school office and Carolyn or Sara will book a time for you. We expect a 100% attendance of families at these interviews, so please let us know of any difficulties you may be having booking a time.

Because of the interviews school will <u>close early at 2.00pm on both Monday and Tuesday</u>.
