ALERT LEVEL 2 ROUTINES TO CONTINUE

Greenmeadows School has coped so well with the different routines and restrictions in place while we remain at 'Level 2'. We were going to review these after the first two weeks back at school - and that time has arrived.

We decided that we will continue on with the following:

- no children in the school prior to 8.30am (unless they are road wardens or going to OSCAR)
- between 8.30 and 9.00am no parents into school grounds unless they are new enrolments or extremely unsettled/anxious children sign in for contact tracing will be required
- a shorter lunchtime from 12.50pm until 1.35pm (15 minutes eat then, 30 minutes play)

The staggered end of the day:

- 2.40pm depart Kowhai Syndicate (Years 1 and 2) & and older siblings
- 2.50pm depart Pohutukawa Syndicate (Years 3 and 4) & siblings plus children who use the Reignier Catholic School crossing on Guppy Road
- 3.00pm Totara Syndicate (Years 5 and 6) and external After School Care groups

Parents picking up children either stay outside school boundary or assemble in one of three collection points which will be marked with cones:

- i. Gloucester Street Gate
- ii. Dental Clinic grassed area GMS OSCAR meet here
- iii. Area outside library

(if they adhere to this - no sign in for contact tracing required)

Parents can bring their children into school in the mornings if they are 'extremely upset or anxious' but <u>must</u> ensure that the contact tracing records are kept. We are still using sign in recording at the office, Room 4 and for the Wednesday morning transition to school classes in the OSCAR room.
