The second half of the year already!!! Great to see everyone back at GMS for the slightly soggy start to Term 3.

WELCOME

We want to acknowledge our latest new arrivals at our school: Dylan King, Isaac Fear, Emma Harkness, Wilbur Johnson, Liam Wilson, Fletcher Menzies and Dian Moss. A warm welcome is extended to you and your whānau. These new students bring our roll to 468.

Also we welcome back Mrs Christy Turner who had her first day teaching with the Year 6 children in Room 12 yesterday. In addition Mrs Sarah Townsend has started back with us as a Teacher Aide.

SURVEY FEEDBACK

You will be aware of the various changes we have had operating at school since returning from the nationwide lock down. At the end of last term the school sought feedback from the students, staff and community about some of the changes we had trialled. It was fantastic to have the 179 parents responses to the survey which is so helpful in our decision making.

As a result of this feedback we have:

- i) Allowed children back into the school grounds before 8.30am. They are to wait in front of the school's main block by the Library. This is for those children who need to be dropped off or are on road patrol. We would prefer to keep the numbers as low as possible for this. OSCAR is available at this time for working parents, which is the preferred option as direct supervision is provided
- ii) Decided to continue with the staggered release times to the end of the day. The responses were overwhelming 82% of parents were in favour of the end of day continuing. Overall staff and community feedback were both well in excess of 90% in favour or 'having no preference either way'. It is certainly much safer in terms of traffic and less stress getting the children away from school.

A couple of concerns were expressed about missing time in the school day. These are valid points to raise. To counter this we have slightly reduced the lunch break ... and we do not have to make up any extra days at end of the year either.

throughout the whole school community. It was trialled for a couple of reasons. One was the fact that many schools have implemented this and found that it worked well getting children out moving, and then calming down by sitting and eating afterwards once back in their rooms. We certainly noticed an immediate reduction in litter as another positive. We were also trying to manage the many extra-curricular activities that so many of our teachers and students are part of - that have practises during break times. However the later times in our daily timetable worked against the potential impact and a number gave feedback of growing hunger during the day. With the split opinions across the entire school, we then decided to return to eating at the start of the break times. This applies to both morning tea (10.50-11.00am) and lunch (12.50-1.05pm).





PARENT INTERVIEWS – 3RD AND 4TH AUGUST 2020

You can request an interview by using our online booking program:

- Go to our school website www.gms.school.nz and click on the 'Parent Teacher Interviews 2020' tab.
- There you will see instructions to take you to the interview booking website, along with the necessary code for booking dates and times at our school (remember to use the school code which is (a5zax).
- Once your booking is completed you will receive an email confirming your interview. These details can be rescheduled if your availability changes.

If you are unable to access the school's website, then you can ring, or visit, the school office and Carolyn or Sara will book a time for you. We expect a 100% attendance of families at these interviews, so please let us know of any difficulties you may be having booking a time. Each child will have a summary sheet of their achievements and progress so far this year prepared for them available at the interview.

Because of the interviews school will close early at 2.00pm on both Monday and Tuesday.
