Greetings from the Board of Trustees,

The Board has remained unchanged since the end of 2010. The Board has a full compliment of energetic and focused people. If you have any suggestions or feedback regarding the school governance or direction please feel free to contact any of the Board members. We are shortly to have our next meeting of the 2011 year and thought it appropriate to update the school community on what business the Board has been working on. The Board is/has been working through the following key areas:

- 5 and 10 year property plan. This is a key area of the school planning and the likely property requirements and resources needed to ensure Greenmeadows campus is maintained and appropriate for our students to learn and be safe. As these only occur every 5 years it is a key factor in the planning cycle of the school.
- The Greenmeadows policies and general school governance has been migrated onto a new platform that will allow more consultation and transparency with our school community and is imminent of being live. Once live we will advise through the newsletter and on the school website as to what policies are being reviewed. This will allow you, as the schools partners and stakeholders, to have input into the direction of the school and the general governance.
- Implementing the budget and ensuring that targets areas for resource allocation is occurring.
- Heart of the School project finalization and preparing for approval and commencement. We will be looking to wider school community to assist with materials to achieve a successful outcome of this project.
- Curriculum reporting, analysis and goal setting to allow the Board to identify areas of need and allocate resources. This is an ongoing monitoring and review process within the board.

We are aware that 2011 will be another busy and full year at Greenmeadows School with many opportunities. The Board of Trustees will endeavor to have Greenmeadows School well positioned to take best advantage of any opportunity that will further enhance our students and staff learning experiences.
