#### **GREENMEADOWS SCHOOL ACCOUNTS**

- Swimming Transport costs the Board of Trustees covers of the swimming lessons for all children and we only ask families to meet the costs of the bus transport to the pools. There are a few outstanding amounts of \$15 per pupil that must be paid to cover this amount.
