SCHOOL FEES AND ACCOUNTS

Many schools in New Zealand will charge hundreds of dollars per child as a school fee donation. Greenmeadows School aims to keep the school fees we ask families for as low as possible. Our fees will stay at the same amounts requested in 2011. As an incentive all fees received before the end of Term 1 will receive a 10% discount to make it even easier for families.

The amounts are:

1 child — \$50 for the year (\$45 if paid by end of Term 1) 2 children — \$100 for the year (\$90 if paid by the end of Term 1) 3 or more children — \$110 for the year (\$100 if paid by the end of Term 1)

You can choose to wait to be invoiced for these amounts in the next few weeks or pay immediately by internet banking. The school's account number for internet banking has been circulated to all families on a pink slip (if you have not received one, please contact the office) and will be printed on each invoice sent out this year.

The first school accounts will be sent out soon. If you choose to pay by internet banking, please include your child's name, Room number and the activity e.g. 'Jan Smith R19 Bus to Swimming'.

Otherwise if you send cash to school please put the amount in an envelope that is clearly marked to make it easy to process. Many thanks.

GREENMEADOWS SCHOOL SWIMMING



The swimming programme for the school is due to start later this term. Totara team classes are to be involved in the first series of lessons starting on Monday 19 March. Each class will have seven consecutive lessons at the Green-

dale Pool at Taradale Primary School. Due to funding received by the NZ Water Safety Council to support the lessons our school been able to further subsidise the transport to and from the venue. The cost of the bus will only be \$8 per pupil for all students in 2012.

Please note that children need to pay for the bus before starting their swimming lessons. The schedule for this term's swimming is:

Monday 19 March to Tuesday 27 March — Rooms 12, 13 and 14 Wednesday 28 March to Thursday 5 April – Rooms 15, 16 and 17

GMS SWIMMING SPORTS

The students in Years 4 to 6 will be involved in their annual swimming sports on Thursday 15 March at the Napier Aquatic Centre in Onekawa. We will be holding championship races to determine our swimming champions for 2012 We will also be holding house competition races to determine our champion swimming house. The house competition will cater for the less able swimmers or those not wishing to enter the championship races.

The children will be travelling to the Napier Aquatic Centre on Tuesday 13 March for a practice swim and also to select children who will compete in the championship races at the swimming sports. Buses will provide the transport at no cost. On both days—the practise day and the event day—we depart from school at 12.20pm. The swimming sports will be a great opportunity for children to display the skills they learned during last year's swimming lessons. Parents and Caregivers are welcome to attend the swimming sports on Thursday 15 March. The first race will start at 12.50pm with the last race finishing before 2.30pm. We look forward to seeing you there.
